Supplements & Discounts:

Visitor's tax & port fees – obligatory - 20 EUR per person per week – to be paid on the spot

SGL supplement: 50%

Third bed discount: 30% for person on extra bed

Supplement for full board: EUR 110.- per person/week (gross), min.10 pax required.

Drink supplement: EUR 16.- per week (netto) – incl. choice of 1 drink-glass of wine, 1 beer or 1 soft drink with lunch

English breakfast supplement: EUR 40.-per week (netto) - incl. 2 eggs, bacon, tomato and mushrooms, or fruit & yoghurt, or similar (regular continental breakfast included in price of the cruise includes: coffee, tea, milk, glass of juice, cereal, bread, a variety of spreads-butter, honey, jam, soft cheese; daily additions such as ham and cheese or boiled eggs, frankfurters, salami etc.)

Wedding renewal package: EUR 100,00 (netto) per couple – includes wedding vows renewal ceremony performed by the captain, certificate, bottle of champagne, small gift

Towels for personal use - the guests will be provided 2 towels per week, additional towels can be rented for EUR 3,00 & beach towels EUR 5,00 per week

Itinerary:

SATURDAY: SPLIT – HVAR

Departure from Split harbour towards Hvar at 1pm. We will spend the afternoon swimming at Pakleni Islands in front of Hvar city and will have an early dinner to get to know your crew and fellow passengers. Overnight in the port of Hvar. Here we can find the Renaissance cathedral with its original tower; also the oldest community theatre in Europe was founded here in 1612. City of Hvar offers abundance entertainment full of restaurants, bars and cafes that are open long into the night.



SUNDAY: HVAR – KORČULA



After breakfast depart for Korčula, the birthplace of MARCO POLO. Lunch on the board in front of Lumbarda (part of Korčula). Arrive to Korčula late afternoon where we overnight in port. On this island you can find more legends, tales and monuments than anywhere else. Listen to the story of the stone walls, which were being built over two centuries ago.

MONDAY: KORČULA – DUBROVNIK

After breakfast we depart for Dubrovnik, which is the highlight of this cruise. On route will be time just for a short swim. Enjoy the beautiful sights of nature along the way towards "the heaven on earth" –according to the famous writer George Bernard Shaw. Arrive to Dubrovnik in the afternoon when you will join our guided tour of Dubrovnik with an English speaking guide. Take a walk through STRADUN – both a street and a square, a promenade inside the city walls. For those of you with more enthusiasm we recommend a walk on top of the 1,940 m long city walls! Overnight in the port of this magical town.

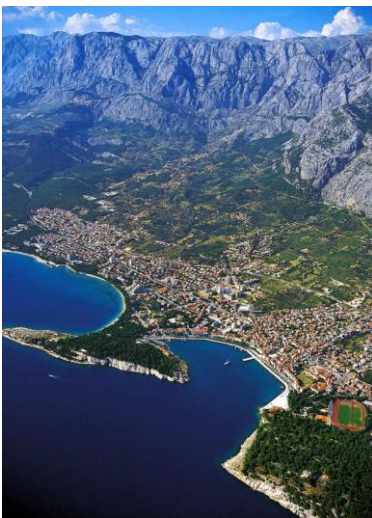


TUESDAY: DUBROVNIK

Today is free day to explore Dubrovnik. Our package includes a guided tour on English. Discover the beauty of history through numerous monuments, little streets, churches... Montenegro full day bus excursion also possible on request.

WEDNESDAY: DUBROVNIK – MLJET

Early morning departure towards Mljet with the first stop on the Peljesac peninsula for a refreshing swim. The whole afternoon is free to look at the salt lakes in Mljet National Park and enjoy the sun and sea on this peaceful island. In the middle of the large lake, inside the National park, we can visit an old abbey and church, or just use a small boat to roam around the National park. Captain's dinner and overnight in port Polaca/Pomena.



THURSDAY: MLJET – MAKARSKA

Early in the morning departure for Makarska. We will have a swimming break on one of the beaches on route. Overnight in the port of Makarska, one of the most attractive resorts on the Croatian coast. Strolling along the streets of Makarska, you will come across numerous churches and other architectural and cultural sights.

FRIDAY: MAKARSKA – SPLIT

We will start our journey back to Split where the last overnight is planned. On our way to Split there will be another swim-break in one of the many bays on island of Brac. Arrival to Split in the late afternoon. Enjoy the view of Split Riviera arriving in Split. Possibility to join our guided tour of Split with an English speaking guide. Split is a monumental city under UNESCO protection that belongs not only to Croatians, but also to you, as it is a part of the world heritage. Here we find an abundance of Roman architecture – of special interest is the Diocletian palace.

Early breakfast after which it is time to say goodbye to the crew and all your new friends!
